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	In response to the damage sustained in 2022, the committee installed CCTV cameras and signage in April 2023 to deter vandals. I am pleased to report that no serious damage has occurred this year. In January, we conducted a survey to gather members' opinions on the use of the newly extended land. The survey results will be presented to EDPC, and we aim to implement, with the approval of the parish council, several of the suggested ideas. These include creating a communal orchard area with fruit trees, a wild nature area, a pond, a composting toilet, additional secure storage (a second container), and an area for bee hives. Rowhedge Allotments is a membership association, and the committee acts on your behalf. Later in the meeting, we will discuss a few matters of importance to all members. We are eager to hear your views on how the committee should address these issues.

There was a detailed discussion around how to proceed with addressing uncultivated plots. There was agreement that there needs to be a graduated approach, there needs to be clear advice on what represents cultivation, there needs to be regular letters clearly stating concerns. c) Mowing rota – Janet updated on need for better communication about rota. 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7. Inclusivity and Disability access.
